Transportation Committee Report 2016

Last year, Andy Newall, the local Highways manager, undertook to replace the flapper valve at the slough on Pilkey Point Road. This was done to reduce habitat for mosquitoes. In fact last year had very little problems with mosquitoes, but it is not clear if this was due to climactic conditions or whether the flapper valve played a part. But it was good to have it replaced and we appreciate Highways contribution, along with Grant Gordon's work in replacing it.

Andy Newall had promised to see what he could do about slippery winter conditions on Lakeview Road, and last year the road was tar and gravel sealed, along with Plateau Road.

The only new topic is a request to look into pedestrian pathways around the busier area of Telegraph Harbour and North Cove to the community centre. This is a topic for discussion at the AGM.

In closing, I would like to express my gratitude for the tremendous cooperation from Grant Gordon and Andy Newall. We are very lucky to have these people looking after our roads.
