

## **WHAT SORT OF THINGS TO DO WITH THE BUILDING WILL THE COMMUNITY BE ABLE TO BE INVOLVED IN?**

### 1. Before construction starts:

Preparation of the site. Help prepare the building for the builders to move in, e.g. move or cover furniture as required, pack up kitchen equipment and dishes and make ready for storage, dig up, move and store any of the transplantable plants that we wish to save from the front planter, remove the memorial benches and take to safekeeping.

### 2. During construction:

Depending on who the contractor will be. Volunteer help, paid or unpaid, apply for a job on site. We would like that ON island subcontractors be considered throughout, balanced with the necessity of completing the project in a timely manner and on budget, but these details will only begin to emerge in the coming months as plans are finalized, equipment is specified, and bids considered.

### 3. After completion of building:

As construction is finishing: clean up around the site, clean windows, redefine the parking area, help refurbishing and moving stored items, help organising the storage areas, painting?, general cleaning, landscaping.

## **HOW CAN THE COMMUNITY GET INVOLVED PRESENTLY?**

1. The project would benefit from a high-level Finance Committee to oversee expenditure of funds and fund raising; participate with Herold Engineering to assess bids; provide support for those doing grant research and writing; provide support for those exploring funding options for "bricks and mortar" and future programming.
2. The FH Ex Committee could benefit from help researching solar applications and rain water collection systems.
3. The FH Ex Committee could benefit from help with interior design.
