TERMS OF REFERENCE: FORBES HALL FOOD SERVICES GROUP

PURPOSE:

- 1. To be a unifying force that enriches the life of our community by providing a welcoming space at Forbes Hall for the preparation and sharing of food.
- 2. To encourage involvement in food preparation and sharing from the broadest spectrum of users.
- 3. To oversee the safe operation of the food preparation, serving and eating areas in the Hall.

FUNCTION:

- 1. To develop and promote knowledge of the Protocols governing the use of the kitchen, beverage station and serving areas.
- 2. To require of all users that food preparation persons have the appropriate current FOODSAFE Level 1 or FOODSAFE Level 1 Refresher certification and operate the kitchen in accordance with government regulations.
- 3. To have two members of the Group certified with FOODSAFE Level 2.
- 4. To ensure that the entire food preparation and serving areas are operated in accordance with the Protocols.
- 5. To provide a fully functioning kitchen with complete serving and eating equipment and ensure that all the kitchen items are in good working order.
- 6. To maintain liaison with every group or organization that regularly uses the kitchen and beverage station.
- 7. To oversee the education of users for the safe operating of all kitchen and beverage station equipment.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

The Group is accountable to the membership through the executive of TICA.

MEMBERSHIP:

- 1. All members of the group must be members of TICA.
- 2. The Group is responsible for keeping the activities of the group within its terms of reference.
- 3. At least one member of the group will oversee the organization and good running of the kitchen and beverage station and be the contact person for regular user groups.

TERM:

The group is a standing committee.

REVIEW:

These terms of reference will be reviewed by the Executive of TICA once a year.
